

## UNESCO CONVENTION CODE REVIEW PROCESS

**In November 2011, thirty countries have ratified the Convention.**

**Belize and Costa Rica have completed their internal legislative process and are officially delivering to UNESCO. We expect to have these two countries achieving this goal before year end.**

## ISEF IN URUGUAY AND ISDE IN ARGENTINA

Uruguay continued with the second year of the anti-doping module at the Physical Education Teachers and Coaches University in Montevideo (ISEF). Argentina, is starting their program under the same basis at the Instituto Superior de Educación Física (ISDE), a public university in Buenos Aires.

The award-winning "Coach True" program was used as the basis of their program.



WADA has launched a two-year review process for the World Anti-Doping Code that will reach a conclusion at the World Conference in Johannesburg, South Africa in Nov. 2013.

The Code Review Process involves three stages of consultation with all WADA stakeholders, who have been asked to lodge their first submissions by March 15, 2012.

We expect active participation of the region in this process.

## OUTREACH PROGRAM

Guadalajara, México, hosted the XVI Panamerican Games in October, 2011 and the Para Panamerican Games, in November, 2011, where WADA had an Outreach Team.
