Declaration of non-compliance of the Olympic Council of Asia (OCA)

Relevant Consequence and Impact on stakeholders

On <u>8 December 2023</u>, the World Anti-Doping Agency (WADA) issued an all-stakeholder communication confirming that the Olympic Council of Asia (OCA) was declared non-compliant with the World Anti-Doping Code (Code) with immediate effect.

WADA will monitor the implementation of the initial consequence imposed on this Signatory. At this stage, no action is required on the part of Signatories.

As recommended by WADA's independent Compliance Review Committee (CRC) and approved by the Agency's Executive Committee (ExCo) on <u>16 November 2023</u>, the initial consequence applied to this Signatory, in accordance with the Code Article 24, and Article 10 and Annex B of the <u>International Standard for Code Compliance by Signatories</u> (ISCCS).

- OCA will be required to pay a fine in the amount of USD 500,000.
